IN CITY COUNCIL

May 24, 1976

It is hereby ordered that the portion of Trowbridge Street described below be discontinued as a public way:

beginning at a point at the northerly line of Broadway and westerly line of Trowbridge Street, proceed

northeasterly by Cambridge Public Library property along two links, a line of one hundred and fifty (150.0) feet and an arc of two hundred and sixty-two and twenty-six hundredths (262.26) feet with a radius of eight hundred and twenty-four and eighty-eight hundredths (824.88),

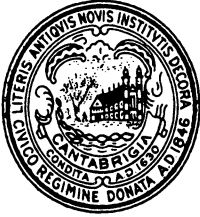
southeasterly forty (40) feet by land previously discontinued,

southwesterly by Cambridge High School property along two links, an arc of two hundred seventy-four and ninety-eight hundredths (274.98) feet and radius of eight hundred sixty-four and eighty-eight hundredths (864.88) and a line of one hundred fifty (150.0) feet to the northerly line of Broadway, and

northwesterly by Broadway forty (40) feet to the point of beginning,

containing approximately sixteen thousand seven hundred and forty-five (16,745) square feet, more or less, and

being shown on a plan entitled "Discontinuance of a Part of Trowbridge Street" prepared by James F. Rice, Jr., Land Surveyor, on December 3, 1975, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

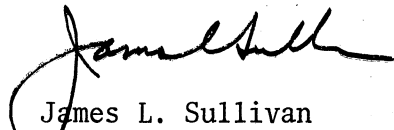
