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In Board of Aldermen, July 7th 1851.-

Ordered,

The Joint-Committee on Roads and Bridges which was instructed by an Order of May 5th, to cause a survey of Battle street to be made and a Plan drawn showing said street somewhat straightened and made fifty feet in width from Battle Square to Craigie street, the Plan to show the names of the abutments and the number of feet of land taken from each, would respectfully

Report- That the Committee has attended to said duty and herewith presents for the action of the City Council a Plan of said widening - the street being made fifty feet in width, except for a small portion of the distance, against land of Batchelder in order to avoid the necessity for the removal of the whole of his row of trees.
