The Members of the Cambridge City Council

As is my right under the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and Chapter 43, Section 98 of the General laws and Rule 23 of the Cambridge City Council Rules, I demand to be heard for 10 (ten minutes) on each of the following matters

1. The wilful refusal of the City Manager to report to the City Council at the last city council meeting the action he intends to take on behalf of the city's cable subscribers to recover from Continental Cablevision money owed the cable subscribers for failure to provide the cable guide. ~~and~~
2. The wilful refusal of the City Manager to comply with the requirements of the State CATV act and Chapter 30 of the Mass General laws by his refusal to act on my Complaints against Cambridge Community Television, its officers, board of directors, its executive director and against Continental Cablevision and his refusal to enforce each and every provision of the City's Cable TV License.
3. The City manager's discriminatory employment practices regarding the Cable Commissioner position.
4. The City manager's refusal to provide his assistance in recovering from Cambridge Trust Bank and any other bank ^{having a Cambridge Community Television account} money belonging to the residents of this city and to businesses unlawfully collected by CCTV's officers, board of directors Executive director and employees for membership fees and for services rendered and for classes and use of the facility without a valid Contract.

By submission of this communication to the city clerk I request the copies of the Philip Sussler report and attached exhibits be made available to each city councillor so that they may follow my discussion and take appropriate action
