GTE SPRINT COMMUNICATIONS

This filing is the fourth tariff filed by GTE Sprint containing rates and charges for the provision of interLATA telecommunications services in Massachusetts. More specifically, it restructures its Direct Sprint Service offering, clarifies charges for nonsubscribers in equal access areas, and introduces a directory assistance charge.
