- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge continues to experience a housing emergency, especially for elderly people, people on fixed income, and low and middle income families, and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Housing Authority has under its jurisdiction hundreds of vacant, boarded up units in need of repair, therefore be it
- ORDERED That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Cambridge Housing Authority to develop a plan whereby prospective tenants could move into these units and use the first six months rent to go instead into the repair and renovation of their apartments, and be it therefore
- ORDERED That this plan be presented to the City Council in no more than three weeks time.
