WHEREAS: The year 1903 saw some big events in addition to the birth of Giuseppe Iozzo: The Wright Brothers made the first successful flight with their plane the Wright Flyer, the Boston Pilgrims won the first World Series beating the Pirates, construction began on the Panama Canal, Henry Ford began selling the "Model A" and President Theodore Roosevelt sent the first message across the Pacific Cable which connected San Francisco; now therefore be it
