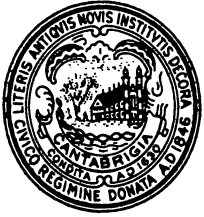
The Finance Department of the City of Cambridge has announced that it will implement special additional hours during the peak collection period, which proceeds the November 1, 1984 due date, for the first installment of the fiscal year 1985 real estate and personal property tax. The additional hours have been added as a result of a request of the City Council to have City staff explore the possibility of providing evening and weekend service at Cambridge City Hall.

For those residents who find it more convenient, the Treasurers Office, located on the first floor of City Hall, will be open Saturday, October 27, 1984 from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 A.M. and will also remain open until 6:00 P.M. on October 29, 30, 31 and November 1, 1984. The Finance Department will review this experience with an eye towards expanding hours of operation.


