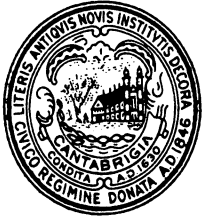
**DATE:** September 27, 1976

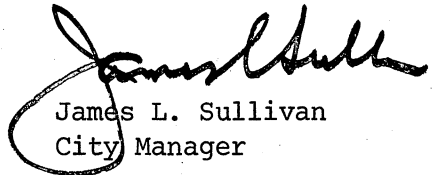
