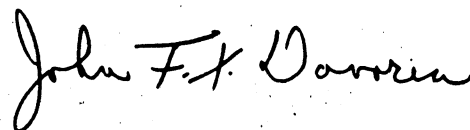

To provide food and temporary shelter to homeless men and women in the Cambridge Somerville area, regardless of race, color, creed, national origin or religious persuasion.

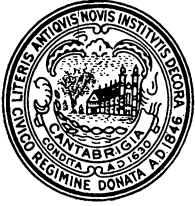

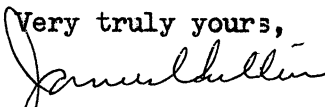
