- WHEREAS: The Academy takes its name from Mother Saint John Fontbonne, a woman of courage and vision, who re-established the congregation of Saint Joseph in France after it had been suppressed by religious persecution during the French Revolution; and
- WHEREAS: The Academy has remained true to its mission statement, "to provide an intellectual training integrated with Catholic thought and principles"; and
- WHEREAS: Fontbonne Academy promotes growth in spirituality, scholarship, and leadership of young women in the changing world; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending a very Happy 50th Anniversary wish to Fontbonne Academy; and be it further
