

# City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen June 28<sup>th</sup> 1853

Whereas, by the seventh section of ordinance No 17, relating to the removal of nuisances and causes of sickness &c, it is provided that any person offending against the particulars mentioned in said section, shall be punished as for a nuisance, which would seem to imply that the only remedy for any such offence, is by indictment, thereby rendering said section very tedious, except by said process, which is at all times somewhat tedious and expensive.

Ordered,

That the joint standing committee on ordinances, be instructed to prepare and report an ordinance in addition to an ordinance, for the removal of ~~fit~~ nuisances, sources of ~~fit~~ and causes of sickness, within the city of Cambridge.
