- WHEREAS: It was with a deep sense of regret that this City Council learned of the resignation of David R. Vickery, Assistant City Manager for Community Development; and
- WHEREAS: David first came to work for the City of Cambridge in 1971 as a Zoning Planner with the Planning Department and due to his ability, knowledge and expertise, assumed the position of Assistant City Manager for Community Development in 1976, a position from which he has provided tremendous leadership in the development arena; and
- WHEREAS: During his term as Head of the Community Development Department, David undertook major urban design and development projects, including the East Cambridge Riverfront Plan and the Alewife Revitalization Plan, as well as developing a strong direction for the Community Development Block Grant Program, emphasizing housing rehabilitation and neighborhood improvements; and
- WHEREAS: Through his efforts the City Council became more aware and grew to better understand the complexities of development and by so doing, enabled this Council to draft and pass appropriate legislation, which has led to the current multi-million dollar development boom in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: David will truly be missed, not only as a competent department head, but as a person who always demonstrated patience, understanding and the ability to listen to all parties concerned; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude and appreciation for his dedication and excellent performance as Assistant City Manager for Community Development; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council extend to Mr. Vickery its every good wish for continued health, happiness and prosperity, as he pursues new endeavors in the private sector; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Vickery on behalf of the entire City Council.
