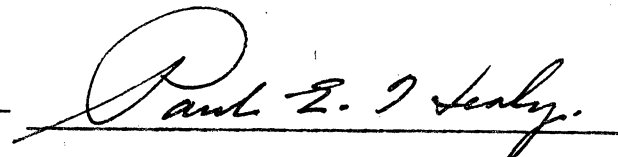
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Bill grew up in Cambridge attending local public schools, graduating from Rindge Technical High School in 1935 and served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Navy from 1942 to 1946; and
- WHEREAS: Bill first began his City service on February 4, 1948 being assigned to the Public Works Department and in 1949 transferred to the Water Department, holding different positions of varying responsibility and rising through the ranks and served as Acting Superintendent from August of 1980 to March of 1981, and upon the appointment of Mr. John Cusack, Bill returned to the position from which he shall retire; and
- WHEREAS: Bill is known throughout Cambridge as "Mr. Personality", always having a kind word or doing a kind deed whenever the opportunity presented itself; and
- WHEREAS: Bill will truly be missed by his colleagues at the Water Department who have always looked upon him as "Father Confessor", as well as for advice and leadership; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to William F. Brennan as he enters a new phase of his life and to further extend our heartfelt thanks for his total dedication to the City of Cambridge, its people and its services; and be it further
