Ordered: That the Superintendent of Streets be, and is hereby
Ordered, to complete the sidewalk on *the westerly side*
of North Avenue from Garden St. to Harrison ^{Place}
by the setting of edgestone and paving the same with brick or stone, as
may be required, and make such changes in the grade of said street
as he shall deem necessary, and remove all such obstructions on the
line of said street as he shall deem dangerous, after giving due notice
to that effect.

The expense of the same to be charged to the Appropriation for
Streets and Paving, and assessed according to law.

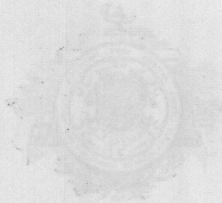
