WHEREAS: The Mayor's Office and the William Joiner Center for the Study of War and Social Consequences (University of Massachusetts-Boston) are sponsoring "Women and the Viet Nam War", including photographs from the University of Massachusetts-Boston archives on display throughout the month on the second floor of City Hall; and on Wednesday, March 24, 1993 at 7:00 p.m. will sponsor a reading and reception by journalists who were in Viet Nam during the war, Lady Borton and Lynda Van Devanter; now therefore be it

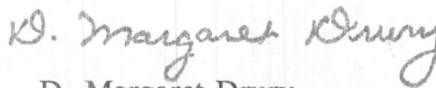
