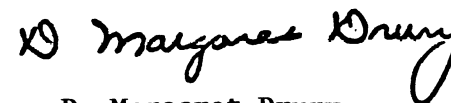

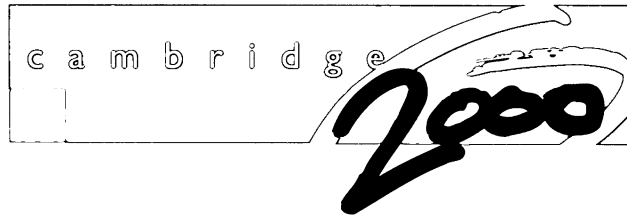

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health for \$125,000 to the Grant Fund Human Services Salaries and Wages account (\$93,908.27), Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$29,091.73), and Travel and Training account (\$2,000) to provide funds for the Cambridge Prevention Coalition to reduce alcohol use by Cambridge youth ages 12-17 by implementing a science-based environmental strategy to address both community norms and underage access to alcohol. These funds will be used to cover a portion of the salaries of three staff members as well as program operating costs and training.
