- WHEREAS: Vincent has long been active in civic and fraternal affairs, having served as President of the Warren Pals Club, as a member of the Wellington-Harrington Citizens Committee and as a member of the Democratic City Committee; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Vincent (Briga) Lampedecchio for his dedicated and faithful service to the City of Cambridge and to further extend its every good wish to Vincent and his wife, Barbara for much good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
