To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$33,755.99 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services from the Salaries & Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Planning and Development Division's three year Community Prevention Coalition Demonstration Grant from the Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP) is now in its second year. During year one, significant salary lag accumulated during the start-up phase of the grant. The Planning & Development Division applied for and received permission from CSAP to carry-over \$40,000 of unspent year one funds into year two, to be used for a range of grant-related contractual and general operation purposes. This transfer request moves funds into the appropriate codes so as to comply with CSAP's authorization to utilize these funds.
