Resolved

Recommending the adoption of the accompanying order, to wit:

One, for assessing owners of estates on Hamis, Norfolk, Tremont, Mt. Vernon Wenden & Winter streets for materials furnished for sidewalks, the total sum assessed being ~~\$12572.57~~ \$1316.⁴⁹

One, directing that a warrant be issued to the City Treasurer to levy and collect the sums so assessed according to law.

between Cambridge and Hampshire Streets,

Winter Street, northerly side,

from junction with Bridge St. to Fourth Street.

The cost of the materials used for such Edge-stones and Brick Sidewalks, to be assessed upon the abutters upon the said Norfolk and Winter Streets, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 191 of the Acts of 1863.

In Board of Aldermen, June 4. 1884

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges in the part of this board, be authorized and instructed to cause the setting of Edge Stone, and the laying of Brick Sidewalks, as follows:-

Edge Stones.

On Tremont Street, both sides, between Hampshire Street and the Souwille line (done from Souwille line to Cambridge St.)

Brick Sidewalks.

On Harvard Street, South side from Norfolk St. (done) to Columbia Street.

On North Avenue, westerly side, from a point opposite the dividing line between the estates of Saunders and Ellis to the South side line of Linnaean Street.

On North Avenue, westerly side, beginning at No. 301 and extending westerly to the junction of North Avenue and Cedar Street.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the proper appropriation, and the cost of materials used to be assessed upon the owners of abutting lands, in accordance with the provisions of Chap. 191 of the acts of 1863.

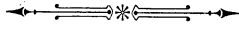

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges on the part of this board be and hereby is authorized and instructed to cause Edge-stones and Brick Sidewalks to be laid as follows:

Edge-stones.

X On Harris street, both sides from Frost to Oxford street.

Brick Sidewalks.

On Elm street, Southeastern side in front of estate of George W. Chipman.

On Main street, Southern side from its junction with Mount Auburn street to Arrow street.

On Harvard street, Southern side in front of nos. 62, 66 and 68.

Such portion of the expense of the foregoing as may be collected of the abutter, to be assessed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 191 of the acts of the year 1863.
