To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$12,000.00 to the Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account. This appropriation will supplement the \$25,000 already appropriated in the Adopted Budget in the Extraordinary Expenditures Account. The funds will be used for the purchase of two replacement heavy duty pick-up trucks with cross bed tool boxes, a replacement trailer to use in getting the paint machine around and in the winter to transport the snow blowers. The two trucks will replace 1989 trucks which have high maintenance costs and need major repairs. The revenue for the appropriation will come from the current year parking fund.
