To the Honorable, the City Council,

Recommendation: Transfer \$66,143 from the Salary Adjustment Account to Public Celebrations

Background: As the City Council is aware, the City of Cambridge and the Cambridge Multi-Cultural Arts Center have had a long standing tax agreement that calls for the City to pay 75% of the annual tax bill of the Bullfinch Building in East Cambridge back to the Multi-Cultural Arts Center. The original agreement signed as an in-lieu-of-tax agreement in 1980 was amended in 1986 to conform with Chapter 59, Section 2B of the General Laws. For the current fiscal year (FY91), the City appropriated \$175,000 for payment to the Multi-Cultural Arts Center. However, the actual amount due to the Center in FY91 is \$241,143 (75% of tax bill of \$321,524). Thus, I am requesting that \$66,143 be transferred into the Multi-Cultural Arts Center Account so that we can meet the terms of this year's contract.

As the City Council is aware, I disclosed in the FY 1992 budget that it was my intention to review the original 1980 agreement, as well as the 1986 amendment during the next several months. It is my hope that a consolidation of arts services or a change in the current agreement can be achieved prior to the submission of the FY93 budget. In the interim, I recommend this transfer of funds so that the City can fulfill the current year's contract.
