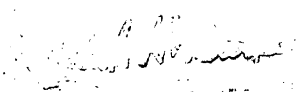

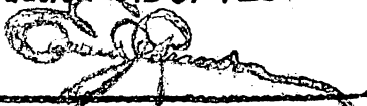

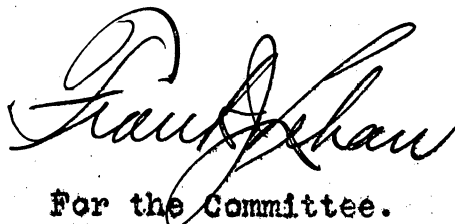

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment of an Ordinance abolishing the Department of Public Safety and establishing a Fire Department and a Police Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Section 4 is hereby amended by adding after the word "department" in the last line the following:-

"There shall be a Deputy Chief of Police who shall perform the duties of the Chief of Police in his absence, and who shall perform such other duties as the Chief of Police with the approval of the Mayor shall order."

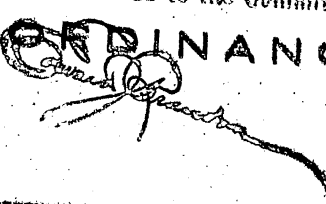
As amended the Section will read as follows:-

Section 4. The Police Department shall be under the charge of a Chief of Police Department who shall be the head of said department. There shall be a Deputy Chief of Police who shall perform the duties of the Chief of Police in his absence, and who shall perform such other duties as the Chief of Police with the approval of the Mayor shall order.

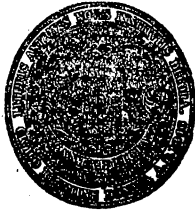

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment of an Ordinance entitled: "The Executive"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of 1892, as amended to November 8, 1899, is hereby amended by adding after Section 13 the following:-

Section 13a. He shall appoint an inspector of dance halls who shall visit all public halls in the city where dances are being held. It shall be the duty of the inspector to see that proper decorum is observed at all times and to cause the ejection of obnoxious or disorderly persons.
