
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I transmit herewith communication from James F. Reagan, Chief, Cambridge Police Department, requesting an appropriation of \$40,000 to the Police Department Schedule A-3 - Overtime; said sum to be included in and made part of the 1972 Tax Levy.

It is my understanding that most of these funds were required to pay for increased police protection during the convention of the SDS at Harvard University.
