- WHEREAS: The quality of effectiveness of these facilities as well as their planning, design, and construction, is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of public works officials; and
- WHEREAS: The efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff Public Works Departments is materially influenced by the people's attitude and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15 through May 21, 1988 as NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK in the City of Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That I call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the problems involved in providing our Public Works and to recognize the contributions which Public Works Employees make every day to our health, safety and comfort.
