- WHEREAS: The City Council has been made aware yet again that the Star Market in Porter Square has taken actions that result in an unacceptable level of noise 24 hours day; and
- WHEREAS: This action, the installation of roof-top air conditioners, combined with truck noise is making the neighbors miserable; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager immediately renew noise measurements in the area of Davenport Street, notify the Star Market that their operation continues to provide a major disturbance to the neighbors, and, on the basis of the noise measurements, take whatever legal action can be taken to assure enforcement of the noise ordinance, as well as delivery ordinances.
