The following improvements are necessary for the continued safe, reliable, normal operation of the C.A.F.D.

First Aid equipment for all Auxiliary apparatus.

Radios for Engine 11 & Lighting Plant 2 (Stolen via no fault of ours)

Purchasing of 50-50' lengths of 2½" hose, 20-50' lengths of 1½" hose, and 2 lengths of 5" soft suction hose.

Purchasing of 22 helmets to meet OSHA requirements, 15 rubber coats, 15 pairs of boots with steel re-inforced toes & shanks.

Purchasing of 1000 feet of grounded cable for LP 2 and 10 circle D lights with all necessary connections.

Repair and/or replacement of all overhead garage doors at our quarters.

Purchasing of an ample supply of spanners, belts, and hose ropes.

Replacement of the vehicle used as LP 2 with a newer, more stable, heavy duty truck.

Sanitary facilities for Auxiliary quarters.

Adequate heating of quarters for the winter time.

Improved outside lighting, better locks, improved police patrols to prevent vandalism and breaks into quarters.

Installation of a house radio in quarters,
