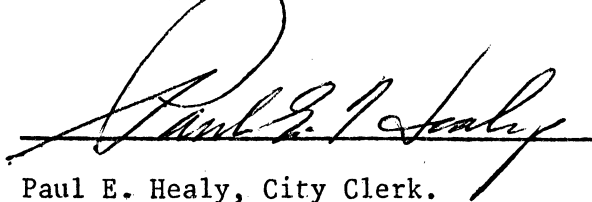

IN CITY COUNCIL
January 23, 1984

ORDERED:

That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to request the appropriate officials of Turkey to release from imprisonment Reha Isvan, former Deputy Head of the Istanbul Department of Education, member of the Turkish Peace Association (Turkiye Baris Derneği) and wife of former mayor of Istanbul, Ahmet Isvan. It is the City Council's understanding that Mrs. Isvan has been sentenced to eight years imprisonment for her participation in a peace organization which was legal at the time of her involvement, and that her sentence is a violation of Articles 10 and 11 of the European Convention of Human Rights, to which Turkey is a State Party. As elected officials in a democratic society, we believe that the release of Mrs. Isvan would reflect Turkey's genuine wish to move toward Turkish officials to inform us of changes in Mrs. Isvan's disposition.

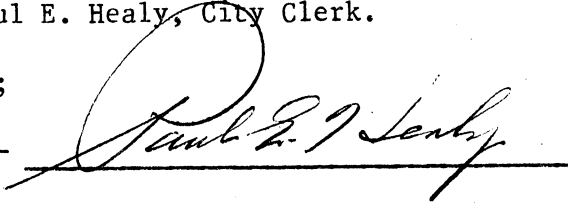

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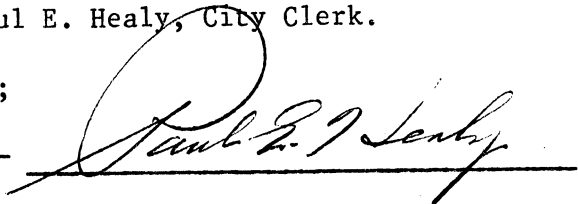

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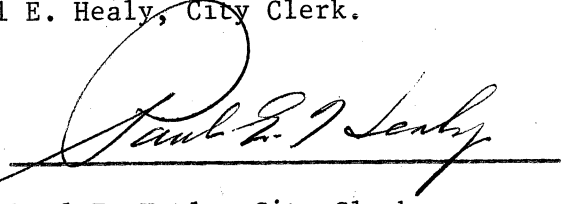
