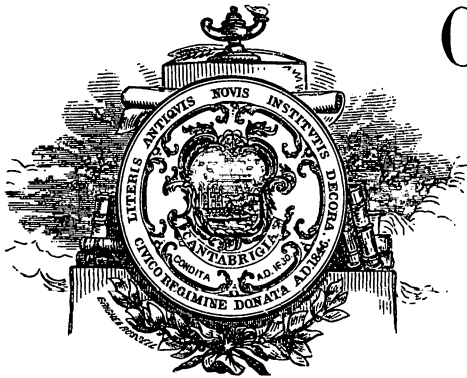




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

April 22/1874.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Fourth Street
between Vine and Charles Streets
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet*
in width between

Vine and Charles Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

C. F. Bowker

dated March 12/1874.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of all fences or other obstructions
standing thereon.
