Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, hereby proclaim March 6 through March 12, 1977 Girl Scout Week in the City of Cambridge, and do further call upon all citizens of Cambridge to support the Girls Scouts now and throughout 1977, with their continued interest, enthusiasm, and cooperation so that increasing numbers of girls may benefit from the Girl Scout program that benefits us all.
