IN CITY COUNCIL

June 19, 1974

WHEREAS:

The City Council ordered the City of Cambridge to enter a Prime Sponsor consortium agreement with the City of Somerville and Towns of Arlington, Belmont, and Watertown for the purpose of implementing federal employment and training programs;

WHEREAS:

The City of Cambridge has entered into an agreement with the City of Somerville and Towns of Arlington, Belmont and Watertown to establish the Eastern Middlesex Human Resource Development Authority as Prime Sponsor with the City of Cambridge as designated administrative arm for the Prime Sponsor consortium;

WHEREAS:

The United States Government has enacted Public Law 93-203, the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 and PL 87-415, the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, which are designed to give employment and training services to the unemployed and/or poor, and;

WHEREAS:

The United States Department of Labor has advised the City of Cambridge as administrative arm of the Eastern Middlesex Human Resource Development Authority that a summer youth employment grant in the amount of \$516,400 will be available for distribution among the five communities on accordance with our Prime Sponsor consortium agreement, and;

WHEREAS:

It is necessary and expedient that the City of Cambridge as administrative arm for the Prime Sponsor consortium forward a grant application on or before Friday, June 14, 1974;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 53A of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the City Council of the City of Cambridge does hereby grant approval to the City Manager of the City of Cambridge to apply for and accept any and all grant awards which may be made by the United States Government pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 93-203 and Public Law 87-415 and be it further;

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to execute any orders, applications, and directives deemed necessary and expedient to implement or assure implementation of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 on behalf of the Eastern Middlesex Human Resource Development Authority including but not exclusive of any action deemed necessary to ensure that the residents of the City of Cambridge and our partner communities in the Prime Sponsor consortium receive full benefits under the provisions of said Act.

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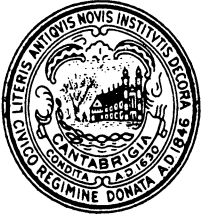

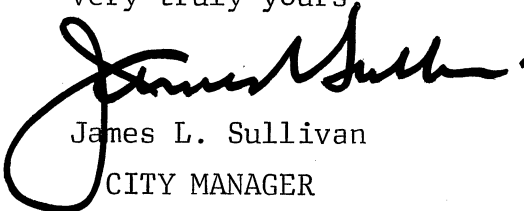
