Gentlemen;

In order to maintain our schedule of operations and completion of this project, we have recently resequenced our work so as to accelerate our construction of the Harvard Square mezzanine. This requires us to form and pour the roof sections, which cross Dunster Street at Mass. Ave., from April 16, 1984 to June 1, 1984. For this seven week period of time, Dunster Street will be closed to all through vehicular traffic at Mass. Ave. Pedestrian traffic will be maintained both across and in and out of Dunster Street for the entire time period. Two-way vehicular traffic will be allowed on Dunster Street to facilitate emergencies and deliveries as posted by signs.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause, and appreciate your continued cooperation during the construction of the new Harvard Square Station mezzanine.

This temporary closing has received prior approval from the Cambridge Traffic Department.
