COUNCILLOR RUSSELL

ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with the Director of Traffic & Parking concerning the lights at Massachusetts Avenue and Walden Street and on Massachusetts Avenue in the vicinity of Churchill Avenue, where Senior Citizens are having difficulty crossing the street. This problem was addressed in a previous Council order and has not been corrected. The time allotted for pedestrians crossing is too brief to allow seniors to cross in safety, especially at Churchill and Massachusetts Avenue where people can only make it half way and become stranded on the median strip; and be it further

ORDERED: That a response is received within one week and a meeting is scheduled as requested in the previous order with the residents of the Russell Apartments to discuss this problem.
