COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: While the Broadway side of Cambridge Rindge & Latin School has blinking traffic signals over a 2 or 3 block area to call motorists' attention to the need for extra caution, no such signals are positioned along the Cambridge Street side of CRLS and the signs that are there do not stand out and are not striking in obtaining motorists's attention as they should be; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Director of Traffic & Parking to review the possibility of installing such blinking signals along Cambridge Street and, at the very least, review and remedy where necessary the condition of the presently existing signs so that their call for caution is more evident to motorists; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on this concern as soon as possible.
