The Department of Public Utilities of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will conduct a public hearing at number 1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts at ten A. M. on March 7, 1977 to discuss proposed regulations governing the filing of requests for rate relief by all Gas, Electric and Telephone Companies, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to draft a position paper for presentation for the hearing outlining the opposition of the City of Cambridge to any proposed rate increases, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to arrange with Richard McKinnon, Administrative Assistant to the City Council for bus transportation to this hearing for all interested citizens of Cambridge who plan to attend this hearing, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to notify all Legislators to appear at the hearing before the Department of Public Utilities and record their opposition to any further rate increases for all utility companies and further to request that a moratorium be placed on any recent rate increases until such time as the citizens of Cambridge have the opportunity to study, oppose and request other appropriate relief.

Notice of Public Hearing

The Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities hereby proposes regulations to be promulgated pursuant to the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 30A, sections 2 and 9 and Chapter 164, section 76C.

The subjects and issues covered by the proposed regulations concern all gas, electric and telephone companies operating within the Commonwealth. The proposed regulations govern the filing of requests for rate relief by all such companies. These proposed regulations would amend by supplementing the regulations promulgated in D.P.U. 15691 and would supercede the emergency regulations promulgated in D.P.U. 19019. Copies of the proposed regulations are available at the Department of Public Utilities and are on file with the Secretary of State.

Presentation of data, views or arguments relating to the above-referred to proposal may be submitted in oral or written form by any interested persons at a public hearing to be held by the Department of Public Utilities at its hearing room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon on March 7, 1977:
