requests that in accordance with Rule 23 of the City Council Rules and the provisions of Chapter 43, Section 98 of the General laws, I, Jack, a professional problem solver and Cambridge Voter be heard on the matter of discontinuance by the individual members of the Cambridge City Council of the custom and practice of violation of the rights of citizens of Cambridge as secured by Chapter 43, Section 98 and the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. by voting on matters on the Council's various Consent Agendas and voting on matters being discussed by various members of the Council before citizens have a reasonable opportunity to be heard for ten minutes on each matter.

I will also discuss the costs and consequences should the councillors refuse to discontinue the above complained of custom and practice.

In the same ten minutes ^{we} ~~I~~ will discuss and present argument designed to persuade the Council to enter an Order directing the City Manager to report back to the Council on Continental Cablevisions response to the City Manager's June 5, 1992 letter regarding the City Solicitor's Opinion regarding Continental violations of the Cable License by failing to provide the Cable Guide and regarding compensation to the Cable Subscribers.

Finally, in the same ten minutes ^{we} ~~I~~ will discuss the costs and consequences should my application for the position Cable Commissioner, not be promptly processed by the City's Director of personnel and my appointment to the position, vacated by Joe Sacey in 1988, not be forth coming.
