- WHEREAS: Since July 1, 1984, section 13-4(e) of the Cambridge City Code has required restaurants with 25 or more seats to establish and enforce no-smoking areas, and to post appropriate signs; and
- WHEREAS: Casual observation indicates that some restaurants are not complying with this ordinance; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Inspectional Services Department to report in writing to the City Council, within two weeks, on its past and future program for enforcing this provision, including the number of citations issued for past violations.
