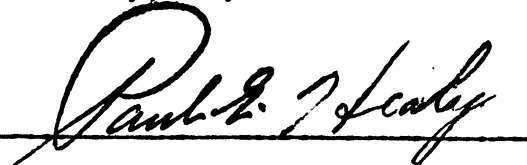

- WHEREAS: The City Manager is presently making plans to fill the vacancy of Assistant City Manager in charge of the Community Development Department; and
- WHEREAS: Much thought is being given by me, Councillor Alfred Vellucci, and the various citizen planning teams in the City of Cambridge to the kind of city planner that should be appointed who would be sensitive to all the needs of the people's neighborhoods and the future directions and goals of the entire city; and
- WHEREAS: By citizen planning teams, it is meant all civic neighborhood organizations, business organizations with businesses situated in Cambridge and citizen organizations which provide direct assistance to Cambridge citizens on matters of specific concerns, such as health, housing, social activities, environmental concerns, matters related to the elderly, homeownership, etc; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That it shall be the policy of this City Council that the City Manager be requested to assemble one representative from each of all the citizen planning teams in the City of Cambridge with the view of setting forth in writing, (1) the type of background they see necessary for the new head of the Community Development Department and also setting forth their views as to what their needs and desires are in regards to the future goals and directions of (2), their neighborhoods, and (3) the City in general; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager arrange for an interview by this committee of the final three candidates who will be considered for appointment to fill the vacancy, from which interview this committee will submit its recommendation to the City Manager, who shall then make the decision; and
- ORDERED: That a "blitz" advertising campaign be conducted in Cambridge so that the wealth of talent potential in our city have first hand opportunity to make application; and also that a large sign regarding this search be posted on the lawn of City Hall; and be it further
- ORDERED: That when the head of the Community Development Department is chosen, that the list of goals set down by the citizen planning team, in regards to the achievement of the future goals of the neighborhoods and the City in general, be mounted and framed and be placed on a wall in a conspicuous place in the Community Development Department Office "for all to see."

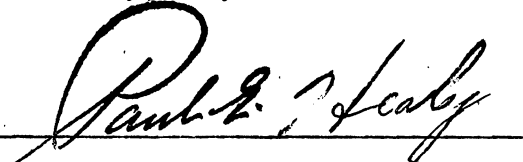
