IN CITY COUNCIL

September 13, 1982

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinance of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Professor Fox Tree of the Native First People (American Indians) for the purpose of displaying and selling arts, crafts and products of the American Indians on the sidewalk of the Cambridge Common on September 24 through 26, 1982, from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk in front of the Cambridge Common on which the display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

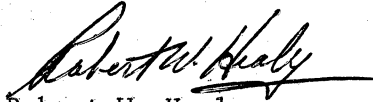
