

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 30. 1885.

Ordered,

That the Cambridge Electric Light Company be and lawfully is authorized, to erect and maintain poles and connect the same with wires for the transmission of Electricity for lighting purposes, in locations to be hereafter specially designated by the Board of Aldermen upon the following named streets, to wit: Main Street from West Boston Bridge to Quincy Square; Harvard Street from Quincy Square to Harvard Square; Brattle Street from Harvard Square to Brattle Square; and Putnam Avenue from Main Street to Pleasant Street,

Provided, the Company aforesaid shall comply with the following conditions viz:

1. Before any steps shall be taken towards the location of poles and connecting the same with wires as hereinafter provided, the said Company shall file a proper certificate showing that it is legally organized under the laws of this Commonwealth.
2. The poles to be erected shall be of a pattern selected and approved by the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, and the same shall be set under the direction of said Committee.
3. The height of the wires shall be not less than thirty feet from the surface of the ground and at a greater height if the Committee, aforesaid, shall deem the same to be necessary.
4. Said poles shall be changed or removed whenever such change or removal shall be deemed necessary by the Board of Aldermen for the time being.
5. Said Company shall file a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, to save the city harmless from any claims against the city, for damages that may arise on account of the setting of said poles.
6. Said poles shall be erected, and the electric light in use and complete, on or before June 1. 1886, otherwise all rights hereby granted shall be forfeited.
7. Said Company shall file with the City Clerk a written notice of its acceptance of the terms of this order within thirty days from the date of its passage.
