In Board of Aldermen, *April 15, 1874.*

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Front Street
be widened on the southerly side
between Main Street and land of Jennings

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *the southerly side of*

Front Street
between Main Street and land of Jennings

as is included between the — lines shown on a plan of *part of Main and Front*
Streets, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *March 9, 1874*, and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Front*
— Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said *widening*

be estimated

and awarded as follows:

<i>John F. Mellen</i>	183.5 " " " "	321.12
<i>Roland Litchfield</i>	104.5 " " " "	182.88
	<i>Total</i>	<u>\$ 836.50</u>

Ordered, That *thirty days* be allowed to the persons whose land is
taken for said *widening* for the removal of *their fences &c.* standing
on the land so taken as aforesaid.
