Cambridge May 1 - 1889

Gentlemen:

I am too ill to attend the hearing this evening relative to a proposed brick sidewalk on the west side of Hawthorn Street.

Acting as the Attorney of Mrs. Thomas P. James and by her expressed instructions to me, and also for myself, I make the following statement and also refer to the enclosed rough tracing of the lots on the west side of this street.

The whole length of the line is 631 feet, the abutments holding on this line beginning at Battle Street being.

Mrs. T. P. James	176 feet
William E. Stone	96 feet
John K. Paine	95 "
William L. Whitney	88 "
John H. Batchelder	176 "
Held by Batchelder and James	352 "
Held by Stone	279 ft.
Paine and Whitney	
Excess held by Batchelder and James	73 feet.

I do not think the public good requires the proposed change, as few persons pass on the west side of the street, and in behalf of myself and Mrs. James I object to the proposed alterations, - and I especially

object to the removal of the linden tree
near the corner of Battle and Hawthorn streets
which, while it stands, very much enhances the
value of Mrs. James's premises, No. 96 Battle Street.

The sidewalk at that point can be so graded as
to present no obstruction to foot-passengers, - and
if it is thought desirable a slight curve toward the
west may be made into the land of Mrs. James.

As to the two unoccupied lots at the south end
of the street, (176 feet front) belonging to me, it
is evidently not desirable that a brick sidewalk
and curb stones be put down until the lots
are graded with reference to the level of the
street and to the future mode of occupying them.
All of which is respectfully submitted.
