

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy-Seven.

An Ordinance establishing the office of
Assistant City Clerk.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sect. 1.

In the month of January, A.D. Eighteen
Hundred and Seventy-Eight, and in the month
of March annually thereafter, there shall
be elected by the City Council, in joint con-
vention, an Assistant City Clerk.
Said Assistant City Clerk shall be sworn
to the faithful discharge of his duties.
He shall hold his office for the term of
one year, or until his successor is chosen,
removable however at the pleasure of the
City Council. He shall receive for his
services the annual salary of One Thou-
sand Dollars, payable quarterly.

Sect. 2.

It shall be the duty of said As-
sistant City Clerk to assist the City Clerk
in recording, indexing and certifying mortgages
of personal property, assignments of wages,

And also if necessary, to attest documents as provided in the second section of Chapter Seventy-two of the Acts of the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty-nine; and perform all other duties pertaining to the office of City Clerk under the laws of the Commonwealth, and Charter and Ordinances of the City, when thereto requested by the City Clerk, or when the office of City-Clerk shall be vacant from any cause.
