COUNCILLOR WOLF

WHEREAS: A number of citizens have expressed concern at receiving phone calls from police officers requesting funds for the Police Mutual Aid Association; and

WHEREAS: The concerns are around a feeling of intimidation particularly as donors are promised publicity and special stickers on their cars; and

WHEREAS: The City Council supports the Police Mutual Aid Association but there should be no sense that police protection or special favoritism is dependent on contributions to the Association; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to look into the manner in which funds are solicited for the Police Mutual Aid Association and to report back to the City Council as to what the procedures are and how the public can be protected from improper influence in this matter.
