- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to confer with the appropriate individuals of the New England Pentecostal Church and the Metropolitan District Commission in order to provide the Church with some assistance in utilizing the property located at the Kennedy School of Government named the John F. Kennedy Memorial Park for the purpose of holding prayer meetings; and be it further
- ORDERED: That should these negotiations be unsuccessful the City Council hereby grants permission to the New England Pentecostal Church to conduct said prayer meetings at the Cambridge Common subject to and in accordance with the rules, regulations and ordinances for use of the Cambridge Common during the period July 26 through August 27, 1980 during the weekday hours of 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. and on Sundays from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.; and be it further
- ORDERED: That permission be granted to construct a tent on the Cambridge Common during this period subject to the condition that no amplification be used outside the tent itself.
