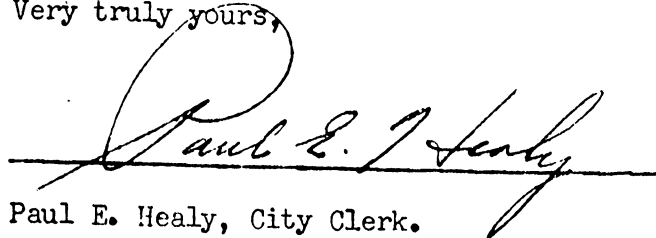
Enclosed herewith you will find the petition of Harvard University
