ORDINANCE:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized to notify the inhabitants of the City of Cambridge, qualified as the law directs, to assemble at the voting places designated by the Election Commission in their respective precincts on Tuesday, the sixth day of November, 1973 to elect at large nine (9) members of the City Council for terms of two (2) years each, by proportional representation, and to elect at large six (6) members of the School Committee for terms of two (2) years each, by proportional representation, polls to be opened at eight (8) o'clock A. M. and closed at eight (8) o'clock P. M.
