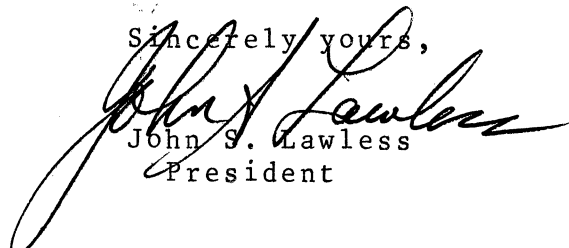
Dear Mr. Connarton:

Under the direction of the Executive Board of Local #30 I.A.F.F. I am requesting the Honorable Cambridge City Council to address the Home Rule Petition provided for in the Acts of 1987 MGL Chapter 697.

This petition addresses the Pension Reform Legislation and the removal of a cap on Pension Benefits on all Public Employees hired since January 1, 1979.

On August 30, 1989 the Cambridge Retirement Board voted unanimously to recommend to the City Council the acceptance of Section 22(d) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws, and in order to insure an adequate pension benefit to the loyal career employees of this City Local #30 I.A.F.F. feels that a positive vote on this subject would be a right and just vote.
