Dear Mr. Healy:

You have asked my opinion as to when the term of Mayor and City Councillors terminate.

The Mayor and Councillors are elected for a two year term. The term under General Laws, Chapter 43, Section 96 would commence from the date they qualified and would expire no later than ten o'clock in the forenoon of the first Monday of January following the regular municipal election under Chapter 43, Section 97.

The tenure of the staff of the office of Mayor, however, is not dependent upon the selection of the Mayor and the present staff would continue to hold office unless replaced by the new Mayor.
