in the Cambridge Terrace, Buena Vista Park and Richdale Avenue Area."

The Traffic and Parking Department has stopped all its installation of resident parking signs due to the fact that when the ground freezes below 2 feet any chance of driving a sign post is almost non-existent as we end up cracking our drivers and breaking posts. This condition is very hazardous to the operators of this equipment.

These streets are scheduled to be done as soon as we can get our crews into the area to safely install the posts and signs. The regulations have been promulgated and advertised as required by law so there will be no delay in installing these signs once the weather and ground conditions permit.

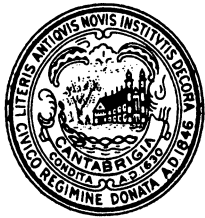

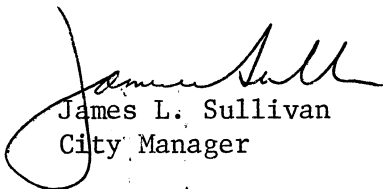
