IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 83 of the Special Acts of 1919, as most recently amended by Chapter 95 of the Acts of 1922, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the third paragraph of said Act the following:

Said Board shall have the exclusive authority to grant licenses under the authority of Section 51 of Chapter 140 of the General Laws and to make rules and regulations for the operation of said massage parlors.
